
MISSION



PROGRAMS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Trash Bash and Watershed Festival

The River des Peres Trash Bash is an annual clean-up of the streams, greenways and parks in the River des Peres watershed and riverbank of the Mississippi River. Thanks to everyone who participated across the watershed to help create better habitats for our native species and clean water for our community. During this year's River des Peres Trash Bash, volunteers joined together at 29 different sites across the watershed for another successful event. Volunteers collected 5.87 tons of trash, protecting our creeks and streams.



Volunteers also participated in marking 311 storm drain inlets at multiple locations across the watershed. Storm drain marking

reminds the community to keep trash, chemicals, and other pollution out of our storm drains. This helps preserve the health of our streams and rivers.

After a successful morning of litter pickup and storm drain marking, over a hundred volunteers gathered at Willmore Park for a Watershed Festival! Between live music, free food, a Unique Trash Contest, and educational opportunities for kids, there was no shortage of fun to be had.

Bike With Your Boots On

River des Peres Watershed Coalition hosted two Bike With Your Boots On water quality monitoring events, one on River des Peres Greenway in June and the other on Gravois Creek Greenway in October. Six trained Stream Team water quality monitors collected chemistry data from the streams and other volunteers assisted and learned about the important roles of citizen science in the community. This effort helps to get a snapshot of water quality of the streams and the data is reported to Missouri Stream Team program.
